

Argentina establishes unique plant-based frozen company in South America

Detail Introduction :

Iceberg Agrícola SA opened a vegetable processing and freezing plant on Tuesday. This model of a company is unique in South America. Iceberg Agrícola SA was established in December 1993 to focus on the production, packaging, and marketing of agricultural products.
