The freezer time shown is for best quality only - mandarin oranges that have been kept constantly frozen at 0°F will keep safe indefinitely.

Freezing oranges is actually pretty easy and will ensure that they stay fresh for longer. In fact, after freezing your oranges, they'll be able to last for six months to 1 year.
