Many people are surprised to discover they can actually freeze oranges for use later. While freezing oranges will preserve them, the texture will nonetheless be affected. As such, frozen oranges should only be used in smoothies, sherbet, or juices.

How To Use Frozen and Defrosted Oranges

1. Smoothies. Smoothies are probably the most popular way of using frozen fruit. ...
2. Cakes and baked goods. If a recipe calls for pureeing oranges, the thawed ones should work just as well as fresh ones.
3. Fruit salads.

Does freezing orange juice affect it?

Yes, you can safely freeze orange juice to significantly extend its shelf life. However, the consistency and texture may change after it is frozen and thawed. Orange juice with little to no pulp retains its quality the best. ... If properly frozen, most orange juice can retain its quality for 3 to 12 months.
