Detail Introduction :

In addition to conventional sugar, acid, and Vc, wild blueberries fruit is rich in VE, VA, VB, SOD, arbutin, protein, anthocyanin, edible fiber, and rich in K, Fe, Zn, Ca, and other mineral elements. According to the introduction of 14 varieties of blueberry fruit analysis and determination from the United States, each hundred grams of fresh blueberry fruit in anthocyanin pigment content up to 163mg, protein 400-700 mg, fat 500-600 mg, carbohydrates 12.3-15.3 mg, vitamin A up to 81-100 international units, vitamin E 2.7-9.5 micrograms, SOD5.39 international units The vitamins are higher than other fruits. Trace elements are also high, with 220-920 micrograms of calcium, 98-274 micrograms of phosphorus, 114-249 micrograms of magnesium, 2.1-4.3 micrograms of zinc, 7.6-30.0 micrograms of iron, 0.8-1.2 micrograms of germanium, and 2.0-3.2 micrograms of copper per gram of fresh fruit.

Wild blueberries are frozen fresh and loaded with 33% more brain-healthy anthocyanins than ordinary blueberries. Their smaller size means twice the berries – and twice the antioxidants – in every bite. When buying blueberries, make sure to look for the little ones that pack a ton of taste.

How long do wild blueberries last in the freezer?

Properly stored, frozen blueberries will maintain the best quality for about 12 months in the freezer, although they will usually remain safe to eat after that.
