

Malaysia's "musang King" Durian Imports Customs Clearance in Liaoning for the First Time

Detail Introduction :

In 2019, according to Dalian Customs, 1,200 boxes of Malaysian frozen durians with shells of 12 tons arrived at Dayaowan Port. Dayaowan Customs launched a "green channel" for agricultural products, with fast inspection and customs clearance to ensure that the imported fruits meet the relevant national standards, they will be released as soon as possible. This is the first time that Malaysia's "Musang King" durian has been imported into Liaoning. The durian will be shipped to all parts of the country for sale.
