During the epidemic period, many foreign trade companies canceled the goods from Shanghai Port because the relevant departments implemented strict control por freight vehicles entering and leaving Shanghai.

"Currently, the rise in international crude oil futures prices has led to higher transportation cost inflation is expected to push up labor costs, which has led to higher purchase costs for im "And because of the rise in US dollar interest rates, the cost of converting the US dollar to countries has risen. To solve this problem, our company allows transactions in renminbi and Wayne said.

In terms of shipping, "Since the beginning of April, the price of sea containers has risen, and little room for the price of reefer containers to fall. The current freight rate is close to the leverage same period last year. As of June, the freight prices of various routes have increased to degrees. Wayne said, "It is certain that China's vegetable and fruit exports began to rise in June, the demand for refrigerated containers will also rise. At the same time, we should pay attentional delivery of refrigerated containers from shipping companies."

"Looking at the current epidemic situation, the international situation, the situation of garlic and the situation of sea transportation, it may be difficult for importers to grasp the period of I prices and shipping costs. However, according to the current export market situation, the price fluctuates within a small range, and the price of sea freight is on the rise. We now need to d job in product quality and transportation and communicate market conditions to importers."
