## Under the control of the epidemic, the export mar of ginger is more sluggish

## **Detail Introduction:**

At present, the epidemic situation across the country is severe, and the prevention and control situat severe, which has added another unfavorable factor to the already sluggish ginger trade.



The export situation is more sluggish under epidemic control

According to customs data, the export volume in February 2022 decreased by 12.67% from January, a average export price decreased by 2.49% from January. Shandong Laiwu, Anqiu, and other places occiplace in the export of ginger, but local industry professionals in Laiwu reported that there are curren export orders due to many factors.

Anqiu exported a lot of goods from China in the early stage, and some of the goods had problems or or after arrival, resulting in slow shipments in the international market and unsaleable goods.

Generally speaking, foreign countries eat less ginger in summer, and April-July is the off-season for expresent, due to the control of Anqiu, the export processing factory has not yet started, and exports a stagnant. In addition, due to the impact of Thai ginger, the export situation in April will be worse.

Wholesale market transactions are slow, and the volume has continued to decrease in recent weeks. In recent weeks, some wholesale markets in the sales area have been controlled. Although most of the markets have gradually opened, the demand in the terminal market is still limited. The market has all

controlled the flow of people. In some areas, restaurants are still closed, and the demand has decreasignificantly. Volume is limited.

On the whole, the current development of ginger is still grim. The weather has been changeable receplantings are also being carried out in an orderly manner across the country. It is expected that some will end their busy farming season, and the supply of goods in individual markets may continue to income to the limited end demand, the price of ginger is likely to stabilize and weaken.
